



# Bank Roll

## What You Need

- Bank Roll Money Cards
- Bank Roll Rule Cards
- Play money (bills, \$1 coins, \$2 coins)

Bank Roll Money Cards	
\$46	\$225
\$98	\$35
\$66	\$59
\$80	\$150
\$74	\$100

## How to Play

- Play in a group.
- Shuffle the Money Cards, and place them face down in one pile.
- Shuffle the Rule Cards, and place them face down in another pile.
- One player turns over the top card in each pile.
  - With the group, use play money to show the amount on the Money Card using the rule on the Rule Card.
  - Try to show the amount in different ways without breaking the rule.
- Play 5 rounds.

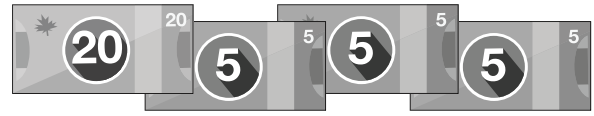
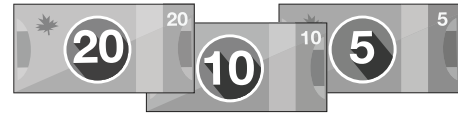
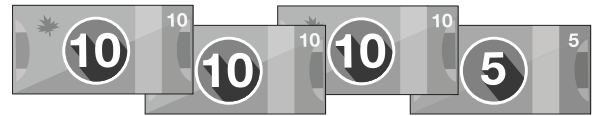
## Example

## Other Ways to Play

- Make up your own Rule Cards using whole dollar amounts.
- Make up your own Money Cards and Rule Cards for cent amounts and represent the amounts with coins.
- Use the same Money Card but a different Rule Card for each round of play.

# Bank Roll Rule Cards



<p>Use a few bills or \$1 or \$2 coins.</p>	<p>Use a lot of bills or \$1 or \$2 coins.</p>
<p>Use more bills than \$1 or \$2 coins.</p>	<p>Use at least one \$1 or \$2 coin.</p>
<p>Use more \$5 bills than \$20 bills.</p>	<p>Use more \$10 bills than \$5 bills.</p>

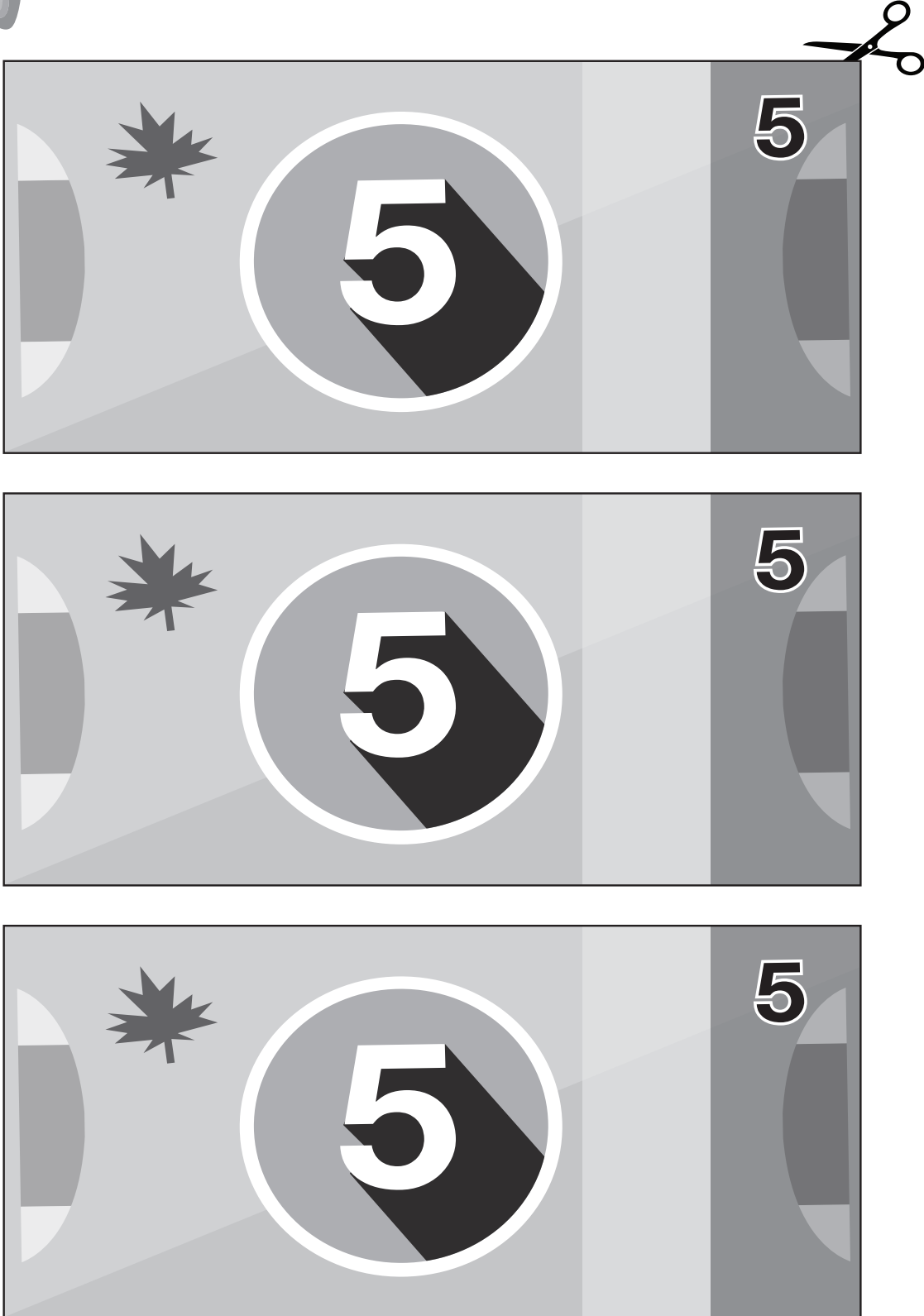

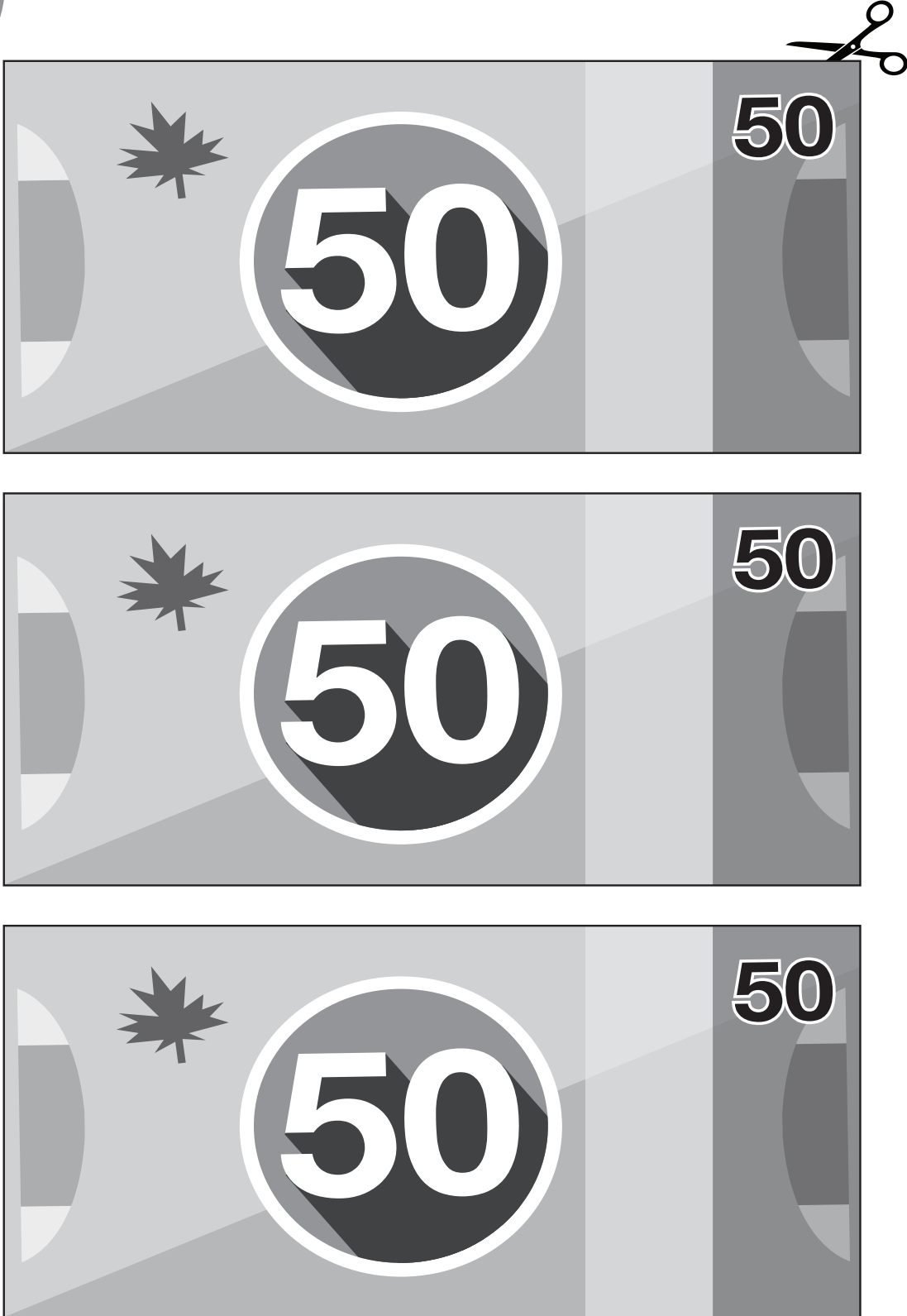
