

Lingo Bingo

What You Need

- Lingo Bingo Calling Card
- Lingo Bingo Playing Cards
- Counters

Set-Up

- Play in a small group.
- At the start of each round, choose one person to be the reader. The reader takes the Lingo Bingo Calling Card.
- Other players each select one of the Lingo Bingo Playing Cards.

Objective

Be the first player to cover five squares in a line with counters.

How to Play

- The reader chooses a key term from the calling card and records it or highlights it secretly, then states the category for the term and reads out its description. Keep track to avoid repeated items.
- Players look for the corresponding key term on their playing cards; if they have a match, they cover it with a counter.
- The reader continues to choose terms and read out their category and description. Make sure to choose terms from all three categories.
- Play until one player has filled a row, column, or diagonal.

Other Ways to Play

- Use the blank playing cards to make your own version of Lingo Bingo.
- Use key terms and other things you know about financial literacy to create a trivia game. Create 25 or more cards with trivia questions (and answers). Decide how players can score points by answering questions correctly.



Lingo Bingo (continued)

Example

Philippe, Paula, and Lise are playing. Philippe is the reader.

He chooses "GST" from the calling card, writes it down without showing, and reads this out: "Under Buying and Selling, tax collected on purchases that goes to the Government of Canada."

Paula and Lise scan the words in the first two columns of their cards. Paula sees "GST" in the first column of her

card, and she covers it with a counter.

Lise doesn't find a matching term, so she can't place a counter.



Read **only** the description (second column), **not** the main term. Let players know which category the term comes from.

Key Terms (do not share)	Description (read aloud, and keep track of items already used in the round)
BUYING A	ND SELLING (Players check the first two columns on their cards.)
barter:	to exchange goods or services without using money
budget:	a plan related to money
cash:	money in coins or bills
cheque:	a bank document you fill in to pay money out of your bank account to somebody else
credit:	buying something today by promising to pay for it later
discount:	a reduction in price
gift card:	a card for a specific dollar value (e.g., from a store) that you can give to another person to spend (at that store)
depreciation:	going down in value after its purchase
inflation:	rising prices
loyalty program:	keeps customers coming back by giving them rewards or points
expense:	money that is or will be spent
credit card:	a card that lets you buy things and pay for them later
GST:	tax collected on purchases that goes to the Government of Canada
HST:	a combined tax that includes both GST and PST
PST:	tax collected on purchases that goes to the provincial government
receipt:	a document that shows you paid for something



Lingo Bingo Calling Card (continued)

W	WORKING (Players check the centre column on their cards.)							
gross income:	the amount of money you earn before any taxes or other deductions are removed							
employer	a company or person who hires others to work for them							
net income:	the amount of money you are paid after taxes or other deductions are taken out							
income tax:	money paid to the government, based on percent of your earnings							
tips (gratuities):	a small amount of money given to recognize good service							
wages:	money earned by working, often paid at an hourly rate							
paycheque:	a statement that shows how much you earned over a specific period of time							
volunteer work	unpaid work, often organized by an organization or a cause							

BANKING AND BOR	BANKING AND BORROWING (Players check the two right-hand columns on their cards.)							
chequing account:	an account that allows you to write cheques							
compound interest:	interest received or paid on an amount that already includes interest							
credit union:	like a bank, but a not-for-profit company							
currency exchange rate:	the value of one country's money in terms of money in another country							
debit card:	a card you can use to get money from your account or to pay for things							
e-transfer:	an electronic money transfer from your bank account to someone else's							
interest:	money paid for the use of money, usually calculated as a percent							
interest rate:	the percent per year of interest earned (or owed) on an amount of money							
savings account:	an account where you save money, often for a long time, to earn interest							
simple interest:	interest that is paid only on the starting amount of money invested							
invest:	to use money to make more money							
loan:	an arrangement (e.g., with a bank) to get money that you must pay back, usually with extra interest charges							
mortgage:	a loan used to buy a very large property (e.g., a house) that takes a very long time to pay back							
transaction:	an act of buying or selling something, or depositing or withdrawing money							



Each player selects one card per game/round.
